# Regulations on Competition based on the Results of the Thematic Research for the College of Engineering in National Chung Hsing University

Article 1 The College has established the Regulations to encourage students to actively participate in thematic research, to strengthen their experimental and practical skills, to develop essay writing and poster presentation skills, and to encourage students to form teams, to train systematic thinking, to develop creativity, and to produce creative and practical work.

# Article 2 Entry requirements:

- 1. Undergraduate students enrolled in the College may enter the competition individually or in teams of up to three students.
- 2. The teams should submit relevant information in accordance with the regulations and be recommended by the supervising professor of thematic research and the department before they can enter the competition.
- 3. Each department may nominate up to 6 groups for the competition.

# Article 3 Judging method and judging items:

The Dean of the College will appoint a Selection Committee consisting of seven to fifteen members of the College faculty and external experts to make the selection.

### Judging process:

- 1. Entrants should submit an abstract describing the results of their thematic research (not more than 4 pages including diagrams and tables). The Selection Committee will use the abstract to make a written assessment and select the best candidates for the second round of the competition.
- 2. Re-selection: Those who have passed the preliminary round should present the results of their thematic research in the prescribed manner, i.e. by means of a poster (which can also be supplemented by physical results). Participants will be required to explain their work on site.
- 3. The items to be assessed include theme and research methodology, results and contributions, content, and interpretation.

### Article 4 Prizes:

- 1. First Place: For one participant (subject to availability), with a certificate in English and Chinese and a cash prize of NT\$12,000.
- 2. Second Place: For two participants (subject to availability), with a certificate of merit in English and Chinese, and a cash prize of NT\$6,000.
- 3. Third Place: For up to five participants, with a certificate in English and Chinese and a cash prize of NT\$3,000.
- 4. <u>Honorable Mention: For a number of participants, with a certificate in both English and Chinese.</u>
- 5. A certificate of participation will be issued to all repeat participants.

6. A certificate will also be issued to the supervising professor of the winner.

### Article 5 Application Deadline:

After the start of the second semester of each academic year until the end of April, the application documents (including an application form and a written paper) should be submitted to the College of Engineering for processing.



Supplementary Provisions: Entries involving plagiarism or infringement of intellectual property rights will be disqualified if found to be so, and the prizes awarded to the winners will be recovered and the entrants will be held legally responsible.
