

# Regulations for Incentive Scholarships for NCHU Undergraduate Students Pursuing Graduate Studies in the College of Engineering

## Article 1

In order to encourage undergraduate students with outstanding academic performance to pursue further studies in the master's or doctoral programs of the College of Engineering, these Regulations are hereby established.

## Article 2

Funding Source: The scholarship shall be funded by the administrative management fees of the College or other related funds.

## Article 3

Eligibility:

1. Undergraduate students of the University who are admitted to the College's graduate programs through departmental admission by recommendation and screening, and who ranked in the top 40% of their class at the time of application, as stated on the official ranking certificate.
2. Undergraduate students of the University who are directly pursuing a doctoral degree.

## Article 4

Scholarship Award:

Each eligible recipient shall be awarded a subsidy equivalent to the tuition and miscellaneous fees for the first academic year. The number of awardees per department shall be based on 5% of the annual master's program admission quota. If this calculation results in fewer than one student, one recipient may still be awarded.

## Article 5

Application and Review Process:

Applications should be submitted in accordance with the college's announced schedule. Departments shall review applications based on these Regulations and submit eligible candidates to the College for further evaluation.

## Article 6

These Regulations shall be implemented following approval by the College Academic Committee and shall be publicly announced thereafter.
